The "Atari ST - 2 port switch box" allows you to connect a single video output to two display inputs - either on the same television/monitor or multiple displays. Designed to make full use of the Atari ST's display options - low and medium colour modes and monochrome hi-res mode.



1. Turn off your Atari ST

2. Insert video plug into Atari ST video port, locking button should be facing upwards as per photo

3. When a Hi-res monochrome cable is connected, switching the unit will reset the Atari ST. This is normal.

The following cables can be used simultaneously on both PORT A and PORT B:

RGB Scart, composite video & audio RCA, VGA multi-sync cable

The following cables can <u>ONLY</u> be used on PORT B:

Hi-RES monochrome (VGA) cable
